Keynote- Sing Your Own Story: Imaginative Play through Music, Movement & Puppetry

LEC - Set 2 (pending)

In this keynote address children's performer and educator, Red Yarn will explore how to sing stories using imaginative play through music, movement and puppetry.

Specifically he'll demonstrate how music and puppetry can engage and support children through imagination.

Educating Young Citizens: 2 Hours

LEC- Set 2 (pending)

We will examine the habits and principles of democracy, as well as the purpose of education in a democracy. Participants will explore and practice strategies of implementing democratic principles into their play-based classroom. Explore and examine what makes good citizens, traits and habits required for self-governance. Participants will select strategies to implement democracy in their classroom.

Speaking with Children so They Can Think: 3 Hours

LEC- Set 2 (pending)

Participants will examine the importance of being clear and precise with language; honoring children; using words to create a world of facts and intrinsic motivation; creating space where children must do their own thinking and make their own decisions; and supporting children as they learn natural consequences of their behaviors.
