IRPP is inspired by the Remida Creative Recycle Center in Reggio Emilia, Italy, which works with city waste management, schools, educators, city inhabitants and local manufacturers.

Remida represents an optimistic approach to our environmental predicament; promoting the idea that waste materials can be resources.

Like Remida centers in Italy and around the world, the Inventing Remida Portland Project collects discarded materials that would otherwise become trash in our landfills and incinerators and gives these materials new life and purpose within educational contexts.
