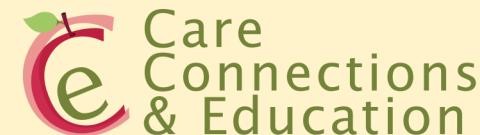
Behaviors that Interfere with Learning 8:30am - 3:30pm CKC: SN
